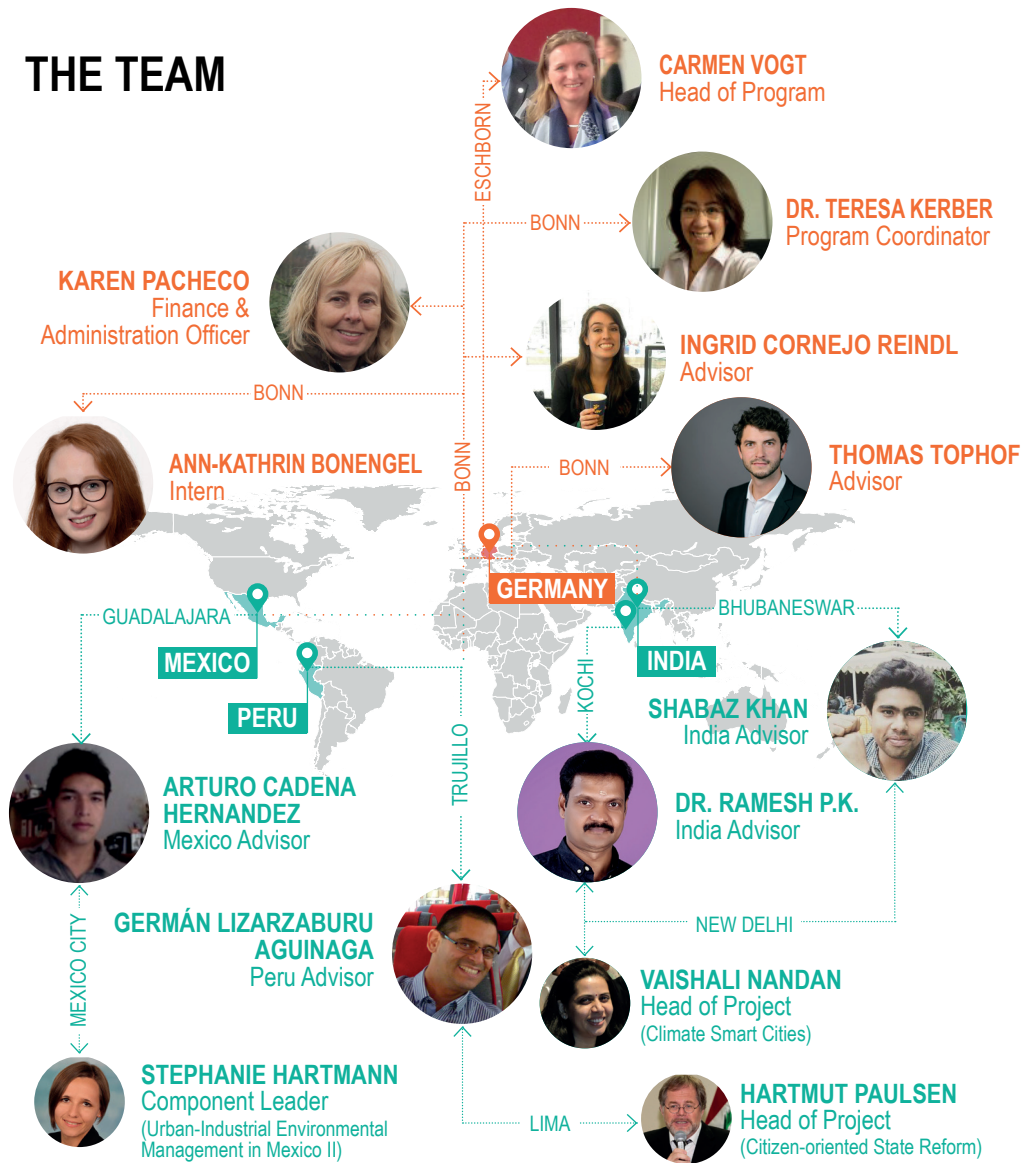
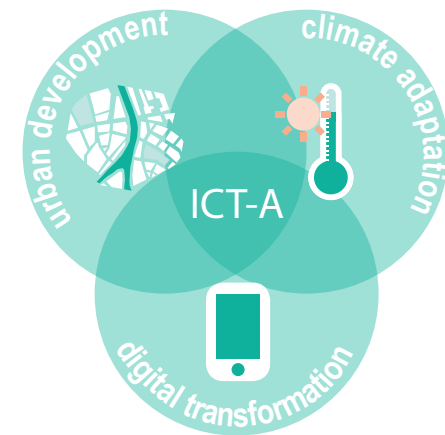


# THE TEAM

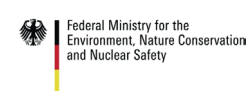
