GIZ is a service provider in the field of **international cooperation** for sustainable development.

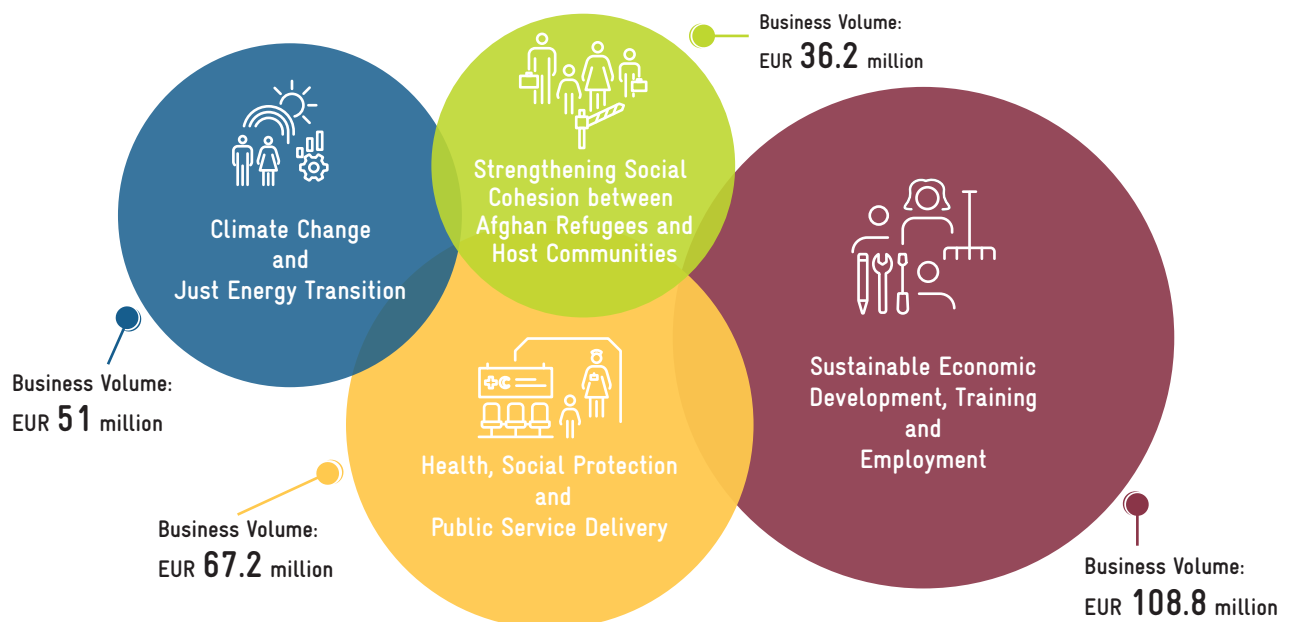
GIZ is a public-benefit federal enterprise supporting the German Government and operating in around **120 countries** with over **25,400 staff** worldwide.

Our Results (in 2022)

	Around 56,800 tonnes of Co2 equivalent/year greenhouse gas emissions were reduced.
	Over 116,460 people gained access to modern energy supply for the first time.
	Electrical energy consumption was reduced by around 171.4 MWhel/a .
	Over 3.8 million people benefited from improved access to public services.
	Around 3.5 million people accessed digital public services.
	Over 12,300 people participated in municipal, regional or national policy/decision-making process, including over 8,000 women.
	Around 5.2 million people, including over 2.5 million women, benefited from improved access to healthcare services.
	187 healthcare facilities were strengthened.
	Over 165 million people benefitted from financial risk protection in relation to general healthcare.
	Around 148,000 people received basic social protection.
	Over 855,700 people , including over 387,000 women, received a better quality of school education.
	Around 25,032 people , including over 9,300 women, successfully completed vocational training courses.
	Over 3,840 jobs were created.
	More than 69,000 people benefitted from improved working conditions.
	More than 637,000 members of refugees and host communities, including over 240,000 women, were supported.
