The Team Europe Initiative on Sustainable Health Security using a One Health approach (TEI HSOH), which aims to sustainably strengthen the African architecture for health security, will be a collaboration between the European Commission, African Union / Africa CDC and other African partners, and European member states. To strengthen and coordinate partners' actions, it is planned to establish a Support Unit (SU), functioning as a secretariat for the TEI HSOH, to be based in Addis Ababa. Since the SU is just being established, the tasks below should be considered indicative and may be adapted subject to need. The SU will be jointly staffed by Expertise France (EF) and GIZ colleagues. Day to day supervision will be from the coordinator (recruited by EF) and the formal line management from GIZ.

Core Responsibility

In your role as **Advisor**, **Monitoring and Evaluation**, you provide support to the TEI HSOH Support Unit (SU) in the design and implementation of monitoring, quality, and knowledge management within the TEI HSOH and ensure learning from other TEIs

Where appropriate and reasonable, you perform further tasks assigned to you by your line manager outside the scope of the job description.

This position is assigned to GIZ salary band 4.



Main Tasks

- Coherent process controle of results monitoring in coordination with the technical advisors and implementers
- Monitor progress and ensuring effective collection and analyses of results
- Provide technical advice to the TEI partners on monitoring, evaluation, learning and knowledge management
- Participate in planning and reporting on TEI HSOH activities
- Support the establishment of an efficient and integrated monitoring and evaluation process
- With the Coordinator contribute to the process of capitalising and improving methods, tools and practices in terms of TEI monitoring and evaluation
- Support and collaborate with the other members of the SU and carry out other tasks in support of the SU operation as needed

Qualifications

- University Degree (Master's Degree or higher) in Social Sciences or other relevant field of International Cooperation
- Relevant Degree (Master's Degree or equivalent) or work experience in one of One Health's key areas (Medicine, Veterinary Medicine, Health Sciences, Environmental Sciences, Global / Public Health)
- At least 7 years of professional experience in Monitoring and Evaluation of international projects, project management, communications, or organisational development
- Experience in the application of quantitative and qualitative methods of data collection and analysis
- Methodological, consulting and cooperation skills
- High customer and solution orientation as well as very good networking skills and intercultural competence, partnership experience, team working, working independently
- Experience of international cooperation in an African context desirable
- Fluency in English is essential; knowledge of French and German in addition would be a distinct advantage
- Willingness to undertake business travel as required
