Core Responsibility

In your role as Digital Delivery Initiatives (DDI) Expert, you will provide support to the Africa CDC in implementing its Digital Transformation Strategy. The execution of the DTS will play a crucial role in strengthening the digital capabilities of the organization. You will report directly to the Director, Centre for Digital Health and work closely with division heads and external partners.



Where appropriate and reasonable, you perform further tasks assigned to you by your line manager outside the scope of the job description.

Main Tasks

- Project Leadership and Oversight: Spearhead a diverse portfolio of digital health projects, ensuring strategic alignment with Africa CDC's objectives and delivering impactful outcomes to Member States.
- Partner Collaboration: Act as the operational point of contact for Africa CDC digital partners, facilitating seamless collaboration, communication, and alignment on project goals and expectations.
- Guidance and Feedback: Provide strategic and operational support to project teams and partners, ensuring best practices in digital health implementation and project management.
- **Project Management Office (PMO) Support:** Establish and lead the PMO to oversee project planning, execution, monitoring, and reporting, ensuring adherence to timelines, budgets, and quality standards.
- **Communication:** Engage with internal and external stakeholders to promote project objectives, gather requirements, and ensure stakeholder buy-in and satisfaction.
- Capacity Building: Mentor and support project teams and partners in project management methodologies, digital health best practices, and technology adoption.
- Risk Management and Compliance: Identify, assess, and mitigate project risks, ensuring compliance with legal, regulatory, and policy frameworks.

Qualifications

- At least a master's degree in Computer Science, Business Administration, Information Systems, Public Health, or a related field.
- A minimum of 10 years of experience in a digital transformation role, preferably within the public health sector.
- Proven experience in implementing digital strategies and solutions at the organizational level.
- Excellent leadership skills and ability to mentor and develop junior team members.
- Proven experience in stakeholder management, with excellent negotiation and communication skills.
- Extensive knowledge of digital health systems, infrastructure, and data governance.
- Familiarity with laws and regulations related to digital health.
- Strong project management skills.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills in English; communication skills in French or other AU working languages will be an added advantage.
