

# Climate Change Adaptation in Agricultural Value Chains in Haryana

Indo German Cooperation and NABARD support FPOs to foster climate adaptive agriculture in India

**The CAFRI-NABARD project supports NABARD and FPOs to systematically identify climate risks and adaptation measures and access adaptation finance:**

Indo-German project Climate Adaptation and Finance in Rural India (CAFRI) commissioned by the BMZ, is implemented in partnership with NABARD. The project aims to support farmer producer organizations (FPOs) to develop business models that are adaptive to climate change.

**GIZ's Climate Expert Tool has provided critical insights into identifying adaptation measures with FPOs:**

To support farmers and their FPOs to identify climate risks and adaptation measures, the project developed the Climate Expert tool.

The tool was implemented with 5 FPOs in Haryana, potentially covering almost 3000 farmer households.

**Climate Adaptive Agriculture in Haryana benefits not just local farmers but agriculture sector in India:**

Haryana is the sixth largest producer of food grains in India. With a changing climate, farmers are exposed to climate change.

**The CAFRI-NABARD project envisions supporting the FPOs with the implementation of identified adaptation measures in a sustainable and scalable manner. For this, the FPOs shall receive support to access and mobilise financing from public and private sources.**



**Project is focusing on selected districts in Haryana to showcase the process of identifying climate risks and adaptation measures:**

The CAFRI-NABARD project worked with FPOs from Kurukshetra, Karnal, Kaithal, and Sirsa districts to support them to identify climate risks and adaptation measures.
